4. Title Specialized Transportation Council.

5. Summary/Purpose:

This bill abolishes the Specialized Transportation Council and its Specialized Transportation Technical Advisory Committee. The purpose of the Council is to support the development of transportation services for elderly and disabled Virginians. The Council and the Disability Commission currently share several commonalities including staffing, chairmanship, and focus. The bill requires the Commission to make transportation issues a top priority on its agenda and transfer the administration of the Specialized Transportation Incentive Fund from the Council to the Commission. This bill is a recommendation of the Joint Subcommittee Studying the Operations, Practices, Duties, and Funding of the Commonwealth's Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Councils, and Other Governmental Entities.
