4. Title Family restrooms at highway rest stops

5. Summary/Purpose:

The Department of Transportation shall provide family restrooms at all rest areas along interstate highways in the Commonwealth. All such family restrooms shall be constructed in accordance with federal law. The provisions of this section shall apply only to rest stops constructed on or after July 1, 2003.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Final.

8. Fiscal implications:

Family rest areas along interstate highways in the Commonwealth are usually constructed using federal funding, for the majority of the costs. In addition, federal regulation must be met. Given this, there should not be a fiscal impact from this bill.
