Duetothelackofdata, theVirginiaCriminalSentencingCommissionhasdetermined,pursuantto§30 -19.1:4ofthe CodeofVirginia,thattheimpactofthelegislationonstate -responsible(prison)bedspace cannotbequantif ied.However,theCommissionbelievestheimpactislikelytobe negligible.TheLibraryofVirginiadoesnotanticipateadditionalcostsassociatedwiththe roleoftheLibraryBoard.
