6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 42.1-15.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the State Library Board;
7	use of state funds.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 42.1-15.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 42.1-15.1. Qualifications required to hold professional librarian position.
11	Public libraries serving a political subdivision or subdivisions having over 5,000 a population greater
12	than 13,000 and libraries operated by the Commonwealth or under its authority, shall not use funds
13	derived from any state aid to employ, in the position of librarian or in any other full-time professional
14	librarian position, a person who does not meet the qualifications established by the State Library Board.
15	A professional librarian position as used in this section is one that requires a knowledge of books
16	and of library technique equivalent to that required for graduation from any accredited library school or
17	one that requires graduation from a school of library science accredited by the American Library
18	Association.
19	No public funds derived from any state aid shall be paid to any person whose employment does not
20	comply with this section.
21	This section shall not apply to law libraries organized pursuant to Chapter 4 (§ 42.1-60 et seq.) of
22	this title, libraries in colleges and universities or to public school libraries.
