6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-270.01 as follows:**8 *§ 18.2-270.01. Multiple offenders; payment to Trauma Center Fund.*

9 *A. The court shall order any person convicted of a violation of §§ 18.2-36.1, 18.2-51.4, 18.2-266,*  
10 *18.2-266.1 or § 46.2-341.24 who has been convicted previously of one or more violations of any of*  
11 *those sections or any ordinance, any law of another state, or any law of the United States substantially*  
12 *similar to the provisions of those sections within 10 years of the date of the current offense to pay \$25*  
13 *to the Trauma Center Fund for the purpose of defraying the costs of providing emergency medical care*  
14 *to victims of automobile accidents attributable to alcohol or drug use.*

15 *B. There is hereby established in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the*  
16 *Trauma Center Fund. The Fund shall consist of any moneys paid into it by virtue of operation of*  
17 *subsection A hereof and any moneys appropriated thereto by the General Assembly and designated for*  
18 *the Fund. Any moneys deposited to or remaining in the Fund during or at the end of each fiscal year or*  
19 *biennium, including interest thereon, shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund*  
20 *and be available for allocation in ensuing fiscal years. The Department of Rehabilitative Services shall*  
21 *award and administer grants from the Trauma Center Fund to appropriate trauma centers based on the*  
22 *cost to provide emergency medical care to victims of automobile accidents. The Department of*  
23 *Rehabilitative Services shall develop, on or before October 1, 2004, written criteria for the awarding of*  
24 *such grants that shall be evaluated and, if necessary, revised on an annual basis.*
