1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER 2 An Act to amend and reenact §§ 2.2-200 and 2.2-204 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code 3 of Virginia by adding in Chapter 2 of Title 2.2 an article numbered 2.1, consisting of a section 4 numbered 2.2-203.3, relating to establishment of a Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry. [H 1212] 5 6 Approved 7 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 8 1. That §§ 2.2-200 and 2.2-204 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted and the Code 9 of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 2 of Title 2.2 an article numbered 2.1, consisting of a 10 section numbered 2.2-203.3, as follows: § 2.2-200. Appointment of Governor's Secretaries; general powers. 11 12 A. The Governor's Secretaries shall be appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the 13 General Assembly if in session when the appointment is made, and if not in session, then at its next succeeding session. Each Secretary shall hold office at the pleasure of the Governor for a term 14 15 coincident with that of the Governor making the appointment or until a successor is appointed and qualified. Before entering upon the discharge of duties, each Secretary shall take an oath to faithfully 16 17 execute the duties of the office. B. Each Secretary shall be subject to direction and supervision by the Governor. Except as provided 18 19 in Article 5 (§ 2.2-208 et seq.) of this chapter, the agencies assigned to each Secretary shall: 20 1. Exercise their respective powers and duties in accordance with the general policy established by 21 the Governor or by the Secretary acting on behalf of the Governor; 2. Provide such assistance to the Governor or the Secretary as may be required; and 22 23 3. Forward all reports to the Governor through the Secretary. 24 C. Unless the Governor expressly reserves such power to himself and except as provided in Article 5 25 (§ 2.2-208 et seq.) of this chapter, each Secretary may: 26 1. Resolve administrative, jurisdictional, operational, program, or policy conflicts between agencies or 27 officials assigned; 28 2. Direct the formulation of a comprehensive program budget for the functional area identified in 29 § 2.2-1508 encompassing the services of agencies assigned for consideration by the Governor; 30 3. Hold agency heads accountable for their administrative, fiscal and program actions in the conduct 31 of the respective powers and duties of the agencies; 32 4. Direct the development of goals, objectives, policies and plans that are necessary to the effective 33 and efficient operation of government; 34 5. Sign documents on behalf of the Governor that originate with agencies assigned to the Secretary; 35 and 36 6. Employ such personnel and to contract for such consulting services as may be required to perform 37 the powers and duties conferred upon the Secretary by law or executive order. D. As used in this chapter, "Governor's Secretaries" means the Secretary of Administration, *the* 38 39 Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry, the Secretary of Commerce and Trade, the Secretary of 40 Education, the Secretary of Finance, the Secretary of Health and Human Resources, the Secretary of 41 Natural Resources, the Secretary of Public Safety, the Secretary of Technology, and the Secretary of 42 Transportation. 43 Article 2.1. 44 Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry. 45 § 2.2-203.3. Position established; agencies for which responsible; additional duties. The position of Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry (the Secretary) is created. The Secretary shall 46 be responsible to the Governor for the following agencies: Department of Forestry, Department of 47 Agriculture and Consumer Services, Virginia Agricultural Council, and Virginia Marine Products Board. **48** 49 The Governor, by executive order, may assign any state executive agency to the Secretary, or reassign 50 any agency listed in this section to another Secretary. 51 § 2.2-204. Position established; agencies for which responsible; additional duties. The position of Secretary of Commerce and Trade (the Secretary) is created. The Secretary shall be 52 53 responsible to the Governor for the following agencies: Department of Business Assistance, Department 54 of Forestry, Virginia Economic Development Partnership Authority, Virginia Tourism Authority, 55 Department of Labor and Industry, Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy, Virginia Employment 56 Commission, Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, Milk Commission, Department of

Agriculture and Consumer Services, Department of Housing and Community Development, Department of Minority Business Enterprise, Virginia Housing Development Authority, Virginia Resources
Authority, Virginia Racing Commission, Tobacco Indemnification and Community Revitalization Commission, Virginia Agricultural Council, and Board of Accountancy, and Virginia Marine Products
Board. The Governor, by executive order, may assign any state executive agency to the Secretary, or

62 reassign any agency listed in this section to another Secretary.

63 The Secretary shall implement the provisions of the Virginia Biotechnology Research Act (§ 2.2-550064 et seq.).

65 2. That except as provided in the third enactment of this act, the provisions of this act shall
66 become effective no later than the beginning of the term of the Governor elected November 8,
67 2005.

68 3. That if funding for the position and expenses of the Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry 69 created by this act is included in the 2004 Appropriation Act passed by the General Assembly, the 70 provisions of this act shall become effective beginning on the date set out in the appropriation act.

70 provisions of this act shall become effective beginning on the date set out in the appropriation act. 71 4. That notwithstanding the provisions of the second or third enactments of this act, effective July

72 1, 2004, the Governor shall appoint a Deputy Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry within the

73 Secretariat of Commerce and Trade to administer the policies affecting the Commonwealth's

74 agricultural and forestry interests. Such Deputy Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry shall serve

75 until the position of Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry is filled.
