17	A. There is created the Virginia Domestic Violence Victim Fund as a special nonreverting fund to be		
17	administered by the Department of Criminal Justice Services to support the prosecution of domestic		
	violence cases and victim services.		
19 20	B. The Department shall adopt guidelines, the purpose of which shall be to make funds available to		
20	(i) local attorneys for the Commonwealth for the purpose of funding the cost of additional attorneys or		
21	to further dedicate existing resources to prosecute felonies and misdemeanors involving domestic		
22	violence and family abuse, and (ii) law-enforcement authorities or appropriate programs, including civil		
23	legal assistance, to assist in protecting and providing necessary services to victims of and children		
24	affected by domestic violence and family abuse.		
25	C. A portion of the sum collected pursuant to §§ 16.1-69.48:1 and 20-15 as specified in those		
26	sections shall be deposited into the state treasury to the credit of this Fund in addition to any other		
27	monies appropriated, allocated or received specifically for such purpose. The Fund shall be distributed		
28	according to grant procedures adopted pursuant to this section and shall be established on the books of		
29	the Comptroller. Any funds remaining in such Fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the		
30	general fund but shall remain in the Fund. Interest earned on the Fund shall be credited to the Fund.

44	the fee provided in this section more than once for a single appearance or trial in absence related to that		
45	incident. A defendant with charges which arise from separate incidents shall be taxed a fee for each
