6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 3 of Chapter 3 of Title 8.01 a section
7	numbered 8.01-44.6, relating to product liability; products containing open and obvious dangers.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 3 of Chapter 3 of Title 8.01 a
10	section numbered 8.01-44.6 as follows:
11	§ 8.01-44.6. Product liability; products containing open and obvious dangers.
12	A. In a product liability action, a manufacturer or seller shall not be liable for a design defect where
13	the claim arises from an injury to a voluntary user of the product that is directly caused by an open
14	and obvious danger of the product.
15	B. For purposes of this section:
16	1. Products with an open and obvious danger shall be limited to: (i) a food product made with
17	sugar, butter, or a hydrogenated oil or trans-fat, (ii) tobacco, or (iii) a firearm; and
18	2. The term "product liability action" means any action for injury or death caused by a product
19	except that the term does not include an action based on a manufacturing defect or breach of an
