6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 46.2-834 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 46.2-834. Signals by law-enforcement officers and crossing guards.

9 A. Law-enforcement officers may assume control of traffic at any intersection, regardless of whether
10 such intersection is controlled by lights, controlled by other traffic control devices, or uncontrolled.
11 Whenever any law-enforcement officer so assumes control of traffic, all drivers of vehicles shall obey
12 his signals.

13 B. Law-enforcement officers and uniformed school crossing guards may assume control of traffic
14 otherwise controlled by lights, and in such event, signals by such officers and uniformed crossing guards
15 shall take precedence over such traffic control devices.

16 C. Uniformed school crossing guards may control traffic at any marked school crossing, whether
17 such crossing is at an intersection or another location. *Uniformed school crossing guards who are*
18 *supplied by their local school division with hand-held stop signs shall use such signs whenever*
19 *controlling traffic as authorized in this subsection.*
