A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 46.2-737 and 46.2-746.9 of the Code of Virginia, relating to special license plates for general registrars.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That §§ 46.2-737 and 46.2-746.9 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-737. Special license plates for certain constitutional officers.

The Commissioner, on application, shall issue to sheriffs, county and city treasurers and commissioners of the revenue, attorneys for the Commonwealth, ~~and~~ circuit court clerks, *and general registrars* special license plates identifying the office held by the applicant.

The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.

§ 46.2-746.9. Special license plates for certain occupations.

On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a printer, magistrate, medical doctor, teacher, pharmacist, registered nurse, ~~general registrar~~, or postmaster, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to the applicant.
