6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-868 of the Code of Virginia, relating to reckless driving;
7	penalties.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 46.2-868 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 46.2-868. Reckless driving; penalties.
11	A. Every person convicted of reckless driving under the provisions of this article shall be guilty of a
12	Class 1 misdemeanor.
13	B. Every person convicted of reckless driving under the provisions of this article who, when he
14	committed the offense, (i) was driving without a valid operator's license due to a suspension or
15	revocation for a moving violation and, (ii) as a result of his reckless driving, caused the death of
16	another, is guilty of a Class 6 felony.
17	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
18	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is
19	for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and for
20	periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
