10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 46.2-1208 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 46.2-1208. Vehicles abandoned on private property other than garages.
13	Notwithstanding any other provisions of this article, if an abandoned motor vehicle is left on private
14	property, other than an establishment covered by the provisions of § 46.2-1204, regardless of whether
15	the vehicle had been brought to that location with the consent of the owner or person in control of the
16	private property, the owner or person in control of the private property may send a notice, by registered
17	or certified mail, return receipt requested, to the owner of record of the motor vehicle and all persons
18	having security interests in the vehicle of record in the office of the Department, describing the motor
19	vehicle by year, make, model, and serial number, and advising that unless the vehicle is reclaimed and
20	removed within thirty30 days or, if the vehicle is a manufactured home or a mobile home, 120 days,
21	from the date of the notice, its owner and all persons having security interests in the vehicle shall have
22	waived all right, title, and interest in the vehicle. If the motor vehicle is not reclaimed by its owner or a
23	person having a security interest in the vehicle of record within thirty the required number of days from
24	the date of the notice, the owner or person in control of the private property on which the motor vehicle
25	was abandoned may apply to the Department for a title to such vehicle. On verification that the notice
26	provisions of this section have been complied with and payment of the certificate of title fee prescribed
27	by § 46.2-627, the Department shall issue a certificate of title to the vehicle in the name of the person
28	submitting the application. The Commissioner shall issue appropriate forms and promulgate appropriate
29	regulations governing applications for title to abandoned motor vehicles pursuant to this section.
30	The provisions of this section shall be applicable in the case of any motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer,

or part of a motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer abandoned on private property, whether or not the locality in which the private property is located has provided by ordinance for the removal and disposition of abandoned vehicles in accordance with this article.

The provisions of this section shall apply only to motor vehicles registered in Virginia. In cases of motor vehicles registered in other states, the Commissioner shall issue certificates of title to their owners on proof satisfactory to the Commissioner that the persons required to be notified by registered or certified mail have received actual notice fully containing the information required by this section.
