6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 8.01-417 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 8.01-417. Copies of written statements or transcriptions of verbal statements by injured person to
9 be delivered to him, copies of subpoenaed documents to be provided to other party.

10 A. Any person who takes from a person who has sustained a personal injury a signed written
11 statement or voice recording of any statement relative to such injury shall deliver to such injured person
12 a copy of such written statement forthwith or a verified typed transcription of such recording within
13 ~~thirty~~ 30 days from the date such statement was given or recording made, when and if the statement or
14 recording is transcribed or in all cases when requested by the injured person or his attorney.

15 B. When one party to a civil proceeding subpoenas documents concerning another party, the
16 subpoenaing party, upon receipt of the subpoenaed documents, shall, if requested, provide true and full
17 copies of the same to any other party or to the attorney for any other party, provided the other party or
18 attorney for the other party pays the reasonable cost of copying or reproducing the subpoenaed
19 documents. This provision does not apply where the subpoenaed documents are returnable to and
20 maintained by the clerk of court in which the action is pending.
