10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 18.2-46.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 18.2-46.3. Recruitment of juveniles for criminal street gang; penalty.
13	A. Any person age eighteen years or older who solicits, invites, recruits, encourages or otherwise
14	causes or attempts to cause a juvenile another to actively participate in or become a member of a
15	criminal street gang shall beis guilty of a Class 6 felony 1 misdemeanor. An offense under this
16	subsection committed by a person 18 years of age or older against a juvenile is a Class 6 felony.
17	B. Any person who uses or threatens force against any person due to that person's or any other
18	person's refusal to actively participate in or become a member of a criminal street gang, withdrawal as
19	a participant in or member of a criminal street gang, or refusal to submit to a demand made by a
20	criminal street gang, is guilty of a Class 6 felony. An offense under this subsection committed by a
21	person 18 years of age or older against a juvenile is a Class 5 felony.
22	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
22	commitment Durguent to \$ 30, 10, 1.4 the estimated amount of the neargenery environmentation connet

commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot
be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for
