- 234567 A BILL to amend and reenact § 44-93.5 of the Code of Virginia, relating to enforcement of provisions protecting job security of members of the military reserves. 8
 - Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 44-93.5 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

10 § 44-93.5. Penalties for denial.

If any employer fails or refuses to comply with the provisions of §§ 44-93, 44-93.2, 44-93.3 and 11 12 44-93.4, the circuit court having jurisdiction over the employer's place of business may, upon the filing of a motion, petition, or other appropriate pleading by the employee, require the employer to comply 13 with §§ 44-93, 44-93.2, 44-93.3 and 44-93.4 and to compensate the employee for any loss of wages or 14 15 benefits suffered by reason of the employer's unlawful failure or refusal. Upon request of the affected employee, the Attorney General may represent personally or through one of his assistants, such 16 employee denied the benefits of §§ 44-93, 44-93.2, 44-93.3 and 44-93.4 while in the performance of 17 18 state active duty.
