10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 18.2-67.4:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 18.2-67.4:1. Infected sexual battery; penalty.
13	Any person who, knowing he is infected with HIV, syphilis, herpes, or hepatitis B, has sexual
14	intercourse, cunnilingus, fellatio, anallingus or anal intercourse with the intent to transmit the infection
15	to another person shall be guilty of a Class 6 felony.
16	"HIV" means the human immunodeficiency virus or any other related virus that causes acquired
17	immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS).
18	Nothing in this section shall prevent the prosecution of any other crime against persons under
19	Chapter 4 (§ 18.2-30 et seq.) of this title. Any person charged with a violation of this section alleging he
20	is infected with HIV shall be subject to the testing provisions of § 18.2-62.
21	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
22	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot
23	be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for

24 periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
