10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by a adding section numbered 18.2-51.5 as follows:
12	§ 18.2-51.5. Death or bodily injury of child in utero; penalty.
13	A. Any person, other than the mother of the child, who willfully, deliberately, and intentionally
14	engages in unlawful conduct that causes the death of, or permanent, serious bodily injury to a child
15	who is in utero at the time the conduct occurs is guilty of a Class 2 felony.
16	B. Any person, other than the mother of the child, who willfully and deliberately engages in unlawful
17	conduct that causes the death of a child who is in utero at the time the conduct occurs is guilty of a
18	Class 4 felony.
19	C. Any person, other than the mother of the child, who willfully and deliberately engages in unlawful
20	conduct that causes permanent, serious bodily injury to a child who is in utero at the time the conduct
21	occurs is guilty of a Class 4 felony.
22	D. A violation of this section shall constitute a separate and distinct felony.
23	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
24	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot

25 be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be 26 determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice. HB671
