A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-194 of the Code of Virginia, relating to unauthorized possession of two or more signed credit cards or credit card numbers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 18.2-194 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 18.2-194. Unauthorized possession of two or more signed credit cards or credit card numbers.

When a person, other than the cardholder or a person authorized by him, possesses two or more credit cards ~~which~~ *that* are signed or two or more credit card numbers, such possession shall be prima facie evidence that said cards or credit card numbers were obtained in violation of ~~subdivision (1) (b) of § 18.2-193~~ § 18.2-192.

2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
