10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 2.1 of Chapter 4 of Title 18.2 a
12	section numbered 18.2-46.3:1 as follows:
13	§ 18.2-46.3:1. Third or subsequent conviction of criminal street gang crimes.
14	Upon a felony conviction of § 18.2-46.2 or § 18.2-46.3, where it is alleged in the warrant,
15	information or indictment on which a person is convicted that (i) such person has been previously
16	convicted twice under any combination of § 18.2-46.2 or § 18.2-46.3, [ or of similar offenses under the
17	law of any other jurisdiction, ] within 10 years of the third or subsequent offense, and (ii) each such
18	offense occurred on different dates, such person is guilty of a Class 3 felony. [ Upon conviction of an
19	offense under this section, the sentence of such person shall include a mandatory, minimum term of
20	imprisonment of 10 years, none of which may be suspended in whole or in part. ]
21	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
22	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot

be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for
periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
