

## 1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 24.2-310 of the Code of Virginia, relating to requirements for polling*  
3 *places.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 24.2-310 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 24.2-310. Requirements for polling places.

9 A. The polling place for each precinct shall be located within the county or city and either within the  
10 precinct or within one mile of the precinct boundary. The polling place for a county precinct may be  
11 located within a city if the city is wholly contained within the county election district served by the  
12 precinct. The polling place for a town precinct may be located within one mile of the precinct and town  
13 boundary.

14 B. The governing body of each county, city, and town shall provide funds to enable the electoral  
15 board to provide adequate facilities at each polling place for the conduct of elections. Each polling place  
16 shall be located in a public building whenever practicable. If more than one polling place is located in  
17 the same building, each polling place shall be located in a separate room or separate and defined space.

18 C. Polling places shall be accessible to qualified voters as required by the provisions of the  
19 Virginians with Disabilities Act (§ 51.5-1 et seq.), the Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and  
20 Handicapped Act (42 U.S.C. § 1973ee et seq.), and the Americans with Disabilities Act relating to  
21 public services (42 U.S.C. § 12131 et seq.). The State Board shall provide instructions to the local  
22 electoral boards and general registrars to assist the localities in complying with the requirements of the  
23 Acts.

24 D. If an emergency makes a polling place unusable or inaccessible, the electoral board shall provide  
25 an alternative polling place and give notice of the change in polling place, subject to the prior approval  
26 of the State Board. The electoral board shall provide notice to the voters appropriate to the  
27 circumstances of the emergency.

28 E. *It shall be permissible to distribute campaign materials on the election day on the property on*  
29 *which a polling place is located and outside of the building containing the polling place except as*  
30 *specifically prohibited by law including, without limitation, the prohibitions of § 24.2-604 and the*  
31 *establishment of the "Prohibited Area" within 40 feet of the entrance to a polling place.*
