10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 46.2-819.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 46.2-819.2. Driving a motor vehicle from establishment where motor fuel offered for sale;
13	suspension of license; penalty.
14	A. No Any person shall drive who drives a motor vehicle off the premises of an establishment at
15	which motor fuel offered for retail sale was dispensed into the fuel tank of such motor vehicle unless
16	payment for such fuel has been made and who willfully fails to pay for the fuel is guilty of larceny.
17	B. Any person who violates this section shall be liable for a civil penalty not to exceed \$100.
18	C. The driver's license of any person found to have violated this section (i) may shall be suspended,
19	(i) for the first offense, for a period of $\frac{1}{100}$ to $\frac{30}{100}$ not less than 60 days and not more than six months and
20	(ii) shall be suspended for a period of 30 days for the second and subsequent offenses for a second or
21	subsequent offense, for a period of not less than 60 days and not more than one year.
22	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
23	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0
24	for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for periods of
25	commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
