*A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-1307 of the Code of Virginia, relating to designation of certain private roads as highways for law-enforcement purposes.*

### **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

#### **1. That § 46.2-1307 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

§ 46.2-1307. Designation of private roads as highways for law-enforcement purposes.

The governing body of any county, city, or town may adopt ordinances designating the private roads, within any residential development *either (i) containing 100 or more lots or (ii) serving as access to an adjacent residential development*, as highways for law-enforcement purposes.
