6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-49.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to violation of court order
7	regarding custody and visitation; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 18.2-49.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 18.2-49.1. Violation of court order regarding custody and visitation; penalty.
11	A. Any person who knowingly, wrongfully and intentionally withholds a child from either of a
12	child's parents or other legal guardian in a clear and significant violation of a court order respecting the
13	custody or visitation of such child, provided such child is withheld outside of the Commonwealth, is
14 15	guilty of a Class 6 felony.
	B. Any person who knowingly, wrongfully and intentionally engages in conduct that constitutes a
16	clear and significant violation of a court order respecting the custody or visitation of a child is guilty of
17	a Class 3 2 misdemeanor upon conviction of a first offense. Any person who commits a second

17 a Class $\frac{3}{2}$ misdemeanor upon conviction of a first offense. Any person who commits a second 18 violation of this section within 12 months of a first conviction is guilty of a Class $\frac{2}{2}$ *I* misdemeanor, and 19 any person who commits a third violation occurring within 24 months of the first conviction is guilty of 20 a Class 1 misdemeanor
