6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 46.2-346 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 46.2-346. Unlawful acts enumerated.

9 A. No person shall:

10 1. Display, cause or permit to be displayed, or have in his possession any driver's license which he
11 knows to be fictitious or to have been cancelled, revoked, suspended, or altered, or photographed for the
12 purpose of evading the intent of this chapter;

13 2. Lend to, or knowingly permit the use of by one not entitled thereto, any driver's license issued to
14 the person so lending or permitting the use thereof;

15 3. Display or represent as his own any driver's license not issued to him;

16 4. Reproduce by photograph or otherwise, any driver's license, temporary driver's permit, ~~or learner's~~
17 ~~permit, or special identification card issued by the Department without obtaining prior written consent~~
18 ~~of the Department with the intent to commit an illegal act;~~

19 5. Fail or refuse to surrender to the Department, on demand, any driver's license issued in the
20 Commonwealth or any other state when the license has been suspended, cancelled, or revoked by proper
21 authority in the Commonwealth, or any other state as provided by law, or to fail or refuse to surrender
22 the suspended, cancelled, or revoked license to any court in which a driver has been tried and convicted
23 for the violation of any law or ordinance of the Commonwealth or any county, city, or town thereof,
24 regulating or affecting the operation of a motor vehicle.

25 B. Any law-enforcement officer empowered to enforce the provisions of this title may retain any
26 driver's license held in violation of this section and shall submit the license to the appropriate court for
27 evidentiary purposes.
