A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 33.1-206.2, relating to promulgation by the Commonwealth Transportation Board of regulations concerning the interstate highway logo sign program; emergency.

Referred to Committee on Transportation

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 33.1-206.2 as follows:

§ 33.1-206.2. Travel Services (Logo) Signing Program.

A. The Department of Transportation shall administer a Travel Services (Logo) Signing Program consistent with the requirements of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices published by the United States Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration. The Commonwealth Transportation Board shall develop regulations, as well as participation criteria, for the administration of the Travel Services (Logo) Signing Program, as a traffic control function of the Department of Transportation.

B. Such regulations shall provide that no participant shall be excluded from continued participation in the program when such participant (i) was a participant in the program on January 1, 2002, and met the participation criteria prescribed in subsection A at that time or (ii) no longer meets the criteria prescribed in subsection A due to reconstruction or relocation of an interstate or primary highway interchange, except when such participant voluntarily withdraws from the program or fails to pay the fees for participation in the program as prescribed by the Board.

2. That an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.
