14	For any conviction under Article 1 (§ 18.2-247 et seq.) of Chapter 7 of Title 18.2, the sentencing
15	guidelines shall not include a recommendation for probation if the offender has a prior felony
16	conviction or adjudication for an offense under that article.
17	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
18	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is
19	\$2,085,082 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for periods of

20 commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
