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11	WHEREAS, numerous aggravated assaults, sexual offenses, robberies, burglaries and other serious
12	crimes are committed every year on the campuses of Virginia's institutions of higher education; and
13	WHEREAS, institutions of higher education around the country as well as private campus safety
14	organizations have developed innovative campus safety programs that would be beneficial to Virginia
15	colleges; and
16	WHEREAS, the Virginia Center for School Safety is developing a list of best practices of safety
17	procedures for elementary and secondary schools; and
18	WHEREAS, no such information has been developed for the system of higher education; and
19	WHEREAS, [information about best practices of the exchange of information about effective]
20	campus safety programs and policies would be extremely beneficial to the security of students attending
21	Virginia institutions of higher education; and
22	WHEREAS, personal safety and security are crucial preconditions that facilitate learning on college
23 24	campuses; now, therefore, be it
	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the State Council of Higher
25 26	Education be requested to develop [and disseminate best practices for procedures that promote the
20 27	exchange of information and assessment techniques concerning] campus safety policies and programs [to for] public and private institutions of higher education in Virginia. [In developing such best
28	practices, the The] Council shall provide opportunities for the participation of and contributions by all
20 29	public and private colleges in Virginia. The Council shall also review best practices established by and
3 0	seek the assistance of other institutions of higher education in the nation and private campus safety
31	organizations.
32	The State Council of Higher Education shall submit to the Division of Legislative Automated
33	Systems an executive summary and report of its progress in meeting the requests of this resolution no
34	later than the first day of the 2005 Regular Session of the General Assembly. The executive summary
35	and report shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated
36	Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports and shall be posted on the General
37	Assembly's website.
