3	Requesting the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia to consider the establishment of a public
4	four-year degree granting institution of higher education in South Central Virginia. Report.

9	WHEREAS, the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia, created pursuant to Chapter 1.1 of
10	Title 23, is charged with serving as the coordinating agency for the public institutions of higher
11	education in Virginia; and
12	WHEREAS, among the Council's duties and responsibilities is the biennial preparation of plans
13	concerning public undergraduate and graduate education, including the location of all public educational
14 15	programs; and WHEREAS, in July 2003, the State of Council of Higher Education for Virginia issued revised
15 16	enrollment projections for the community colleges and public four-year institutions of higher education
17	which predicts that the actual growth in the number students may reach 61,000 students by 2010; and
18	WHEREAS, institutions of higher education serve the dual role of educating students and anchoring
19	economic development in the communities where they are located; and
20	WHEREAS, there is currently no public four-year or graduate degree-granting college or university
21	in South Central Virginia; and
22	WHEREAS, in the absence of a public four-year institution of higher education, educational
23 24	opportunities for Virginians who reside in South Central Virginia are limited and the economic competitiveness of the region is restricted; and
25	WHEREAS, the Joint Subcommittee to Study the Need for Increased Availability of Higher
26	Education Services in South Central Virginia (Senate Joint Resolution No. 459 (1999)) determined that a
27	need exists for a public four-year institution of higher education in South Central Virginia; now,
28	therefore, be it
29	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the State Council of Higher
<b>30</b>	Education for Virginia be requested to consider the establishment of a public four-year degree granting
31 32	institution of higher education in South Central Virginia in developing its systemwide needs assessment plan for higher education in the Commonwealth. Such institution shall strengthen and support existing
32 33	public and private institutions of higher education in the South Central Virginia region. In its
34	deliberations to develop the plan, the Council shall (i) [ solicit the participation of and ] collaborate with
35	all interested parties, and (ii) evaluate all available options, including, but not limited to, the creation of
36	a branch campus of an existing institution in the South Central Virginia region.
37	The State Council of Higher Education for Virginia shall submit to the Division of Legislative
38	Automated Systems an executive summary and report of its progress in meeting the request of this
39 40	resolution no later than the first day of the 2005 Regular Session of the General Assembly. The
40 41	executive summary and report shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports and shall be
42	posted on the General Assembly's website.
