Blanton of Caroline County, a 23-year veteran of service with 7 the Virginia Department of State Police, died on October 16, 2003; and WHEREAS, a native of Caroline County, Taylor Blanton graduated from Caroline County High 8 9 trooper; and December 19, 1980, earning a reputation among his classmates for perseverance and determination; and in 1988 to Special Agent with the Bureau of Criminal Investigations; and assigned to the auto theft unit before transferring to supervise the newly formed computer crimes unit, where he served until his death; and 17 WHEREAS, throughout his career with the Virginia State Police, Taylor Blanton earned respect from 18 19 his colleagues and superiors for his energy, talent, determination, and devotion to a career he loved; and WHEREAS, during his too-short life, Taylor Blanton established an exemplary record of service to 20 21 his community, the Virginia Department of State Police, and the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it 22 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly note with sadness the untimely loss of a skilled and dedicated public servant, First Sergeant Taylor V. Blanton;
