6 WHEREAS, in 1896 a group of community-spirited women formed the Norfolk City Union of the King's Daughters to provide medical care for indigent mothers and their children; and WHEREAS, in 1961 the King's Daughters' Children's Hospital was built, offering the Norfolk 7

8 community 88 beds and a variety of services; and 9

WHEREAS, in 1979 the name of the hospital was changed to Children's Hospital of the King's 10 Daughters and is today Virginia's only free-standing, full-service pediatric hospital, treating children 11 from birth through age 21; and 12

WHEREAS, a not-for-profit hospital, Children's Hospital of the King's Daughters offers a regional 13 14 pediatric referral center for southeastern Virginia, the Eastern Shore, and northeastern North Carolina, an 15 area with a population of nearly two million; and

WHEREAS, Children's Hospital of the King's Daughters also treats children from across the United 16 17 States and around the world; and

18 WHEREAS, Children's Hospital of the King's Daughters is home to the Eastern Virginia Medical 19 School's pediatric residency program, training the nation's pediatricians, pediatric specialists, and 20 pediatric nurses; and

WHEREAS, Children's Hospital of the King's Daughters services more than 5,900 inpatient 21 admissions and more than 99,000 outpatient visits annually, and its emergency center handles an 22 23 additional 43,000 visits each year; and

24 WHEREAS, Children's Hospital of the King's Daughters offers a wide array of specialties and 25 services, including the Children's Specialty Group, CHKD Surgical Group, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, 26 Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, and numerous others; and

27 WHEREAS, the Children's Health Line is a free service that helps locate a pediatrician or pediatric 28 specialist, along with information on parenting, and the Center for Pediatric Research, a joint program 29 with the Eastern Virginia Medical School, is home to a nationally recognized pediatric research program; 30 and

31 WHEREAS, for more than a century, the dedicated staff of Children's Hospital of the King's 32 Daughters has provided the citizens of Hampton Roads and the Commonwealth with the finest in 33 pediatric medical care; now, therefore, be it

34 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 35 commend Children's Hospital of the King's Daughters for its dedicated and ongoing service to the 36 citizens of Virginia; and, be it
