on a one-on-one interview and on their talent, poise, scholastic achievement, and fitness; and WHEREAS, in addition to the Junior Miss pageant, Sarah-Elizabeth Hurt and the other contestants participated in a "Be Your Best Self" day camp at the Salem Public Library, which included a luncheon

with the president of Roanoke College; and WHEREAS, a senior at Roanoke Catholic School, Sarah-Elizabeth Hurt won scholarships worth

\$5,250 for winning the Junior Miss title and for her runner-up finish in the talent competition for her piano performance; and WHEREAS, in June 2004, Sarah-Elizabeth Hurt will represent the Commonwealth for two weeks in

Mobile, Alabama, where she will compete for the title of America's Junior Miss and a share of more than \$200,000 in scholarships; now, therefore, be it
