7	WHEREAS, Alex Gulotta, a Charlottesville attorney and the executive director of the Legal Aid
8	Justice Center, received the 2003 Charles Dorsey Award from the National Legal Aid and Defender
9	Association; and
10	WHEREAS, the Charles Dorsey Award is given every two years in recognition of "extraordinary and
11	dedicated service" in the equal justice community; and
12	WHEREAS, Alex Gulotta joined the Charlottesville Albemarle Legal Aid Society in 1994 and has,
13	for the past decade, provided energetic and innovative leadership on behalf of the society's clients; and
14	WHEREAS, in response to 1996 Congressional restrictions on federally funded legal aid programs,

	Alex Gulotta led the effort to transform the Charlottesville program into the Legal Aid Justice Center,
16	which relies on private donations not subject to government restrictions; and
17	WHEREAS, Alex Gulotta was instrumental in the creation of two new programs at the Legal Aid
18	Justice Center, the first assisted farm and immigrant workers and the second focused solely on the legal
19	needs of children; and
20	WHEREAS, Alex Gulotta's transformed Legal Aid Justice Center and its innovative programs have
21	become models for other legal aid organizations across the country, and Alex Gulotta has helped to
22	establish similar programs in Richmond and Petersburg; and
23	WHEREAS, Alex Gulotta has assisted in securing a permanent home for the Legal Aid Justice
24	Center in a newly renovated building that houses several other community organizations; and
25	WHEREAS, described by colleagues as inexhaustible, talented, relentless, creative, and optimistic,
26	Alex Gulotta is a worthy recipient of the prestigious Charles Dorsey Award; now, therefore, be it
27	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby
28	commend Alex Gulotta for his outstanding work with the Legal Aid Justice Center; and, be it
