11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. § 1. Any study by the Virginia Department of Transportation of possible improvements to Interstate
13	Route 66 outside the Capital Beltway (Interstate Route 495) shall include consideration of the
14	desirability and feasibility of constructing High-Occupancy Toll (HOT) lanes in conjunction with any
15	such improvements.
16	For the purposes of this act, HOT lanes shall mean highway lanes ordinarily restricted to use by
17	high-occupancy vehicles, but which may be used by a nonhigh-occupancy vehicle if a toll is paid by the
18	operator for the use of the facility by such nonhigh-occupancy vehicle.
