234567 A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 15.2-1609.1:01, relating to number of jail deputies. 8

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

9 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 15.2-1609.1:01 as follows: § 15.2-1609.1:01. Number of jail deputies. 10

The Compensation Board shall allocate jail deputy positions at the lesser of the sheriff or 11 12 superintendent's request, as recommended by the Department of Corrections, or at a ratio of not more than one jail deputy for every three beds of operational capacity. Operational capacity shall be 13 determined by the Department of Corrections. In those jails experiencing overcrowding, the 14 15 Compensation Board shall allocate jail deputy positions at the lesser of the sheriff or the 16 superintendent's request, as recommended by the Department of Corrections, or at a ratio of not more 17 than one additional jail deputy for every five average annual daily prisoners above operation capacity. Should there be any disagreement between the sheriff and the Compensation Board regarding staffing 18 for the jail, then the local governing body may address such objections under the provisions of 19 20 § 15.2-1636.8.

21 For the purposes of this section, "overcrowding" is defined as when the average annual daily 22 population exceeds the operational capacity.

23 Should overcrowding be reduced or eliminated in any jail, the Compensation Board shall reallocate 24 jail deputy positions previously assigned due to the overcrowding in accordance with the Board's

25 staffing standards for alternatives to incarceration programs or court services within the sheriff's office or among other jails in the Commonwealth. 26
