14	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
15	1. That § 33.1-23.03:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
16	§ 33.1-23.03:1. Transportation Trust Fund.
17	There is hereby created in the Department of the Treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known
18 19	as the Transportation Trust Fund, consisting of:
	1. Funds remaining for highway construction purposes, among the several highway systems pursuant
20	to § 33.1-23.1.
21 22	2. [Repealed.]
22	3. The additional revenues generated by enactments of Chapters 11, 12 and 15 of the Acts of
23 24	Assembly, 1986 Special Session, and designated for this fund. 4. Tolls and other revenues derived from the projects financed or refinanced pursuant to this title
25	which are payable into the state treasury and tolls and other revenues derived from other transportation
23 26	projects, which may include upon the request of the applicable appointed governing body, as soon as
27	their obligations have been satisfied, such tolls and revenue derived for transportation projects pursuant
28	to § 33.1-253 (Chesapeake Bay Bridge and Tunnel District) and § 33.1-320 (Richmond Metropolitan
29	Authority) or if the appointed governing body requests refunding or advanced refunding by the Board
3 0	and such refunding or advanced refunding is approved by the General Assembly. Such funds shall be
31	held in separate subaccounts of the Transportation Trust Fund to the extent required by law or the
32	Board.
33	5. Tolls and other revenues derived from the Richmond-Petersburg Turnpike, provided that such
34	funds shall be held in a separate subaccount of the Transportation Trust Fund and allocated as set forth
35	in Chapter 574 of the Acts of Assembly of 1983 until expiration of that Act.
36	6. Such other funds as may be appropriated by the General Assembly from time to time, and
37	designated for this fund.
38	7. All interest, dividends and appreciation which may accrue to the Transportation Trust Fund and
39	the Highway Maintenance and Construction Fund, except that interest on funds becoming part of the
40	Transportation Trust Fund under subdivision 1 and the Highway Maintenance and Construction Fund
41	shall not become part of the Transportation Trust Fund until July 1, 1988.
42	8. All amounts required by contract to be paid over to the Transportation Trust Fund.
43	9. Except as otherwise provided by the Constitution of Virginia or federal law, all Transportation
44	Trust Fund proceeds remaining in the Transportation Trust Fund after allocations to the Commonwealth
45	Port Fund, Commonwealth Airport Fund and Commonwealth Mass Transit Fund as provided in
46	§ 33.1-23.03:2 shall be allocated for highway construction as provided in §§ 33.1-23.1, 33.1-23.2,
47	33.1-23.3, 33.1-23.4, and 33.1-23.5:1.2.
48	That §§ 33.1-23.03:4, 33.1-23.1:1, 33.1-221, 33.1-221.1:1, 33.1-221.1:3, 33.1-221.1:6, and 33.1-223 of
