6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 18.2-32.2, relating to killing a
7	fetus; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-32.2 as follows:
10	§ 18.2-32.2. Killing a fetus; penalty.
11	A. Any person who unlawfully, willfully, deliberately, maliciously and with premeditation kills the
12	fetus of another is guilty of a Class 2 felony.
13	B. Any person who unlawfully, willfully, deliberately and maliciously kills the fetus of another is
14	guilty of a felony punishable by confinement in a state correctional facility for not less than five nor
15	more than 40 years.
