3	(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Transportation

7	A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-1500 of the Code of Virginia, relating to motor vehicle dealers; certain mobile cranes.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
<b>9</b>	1. That § 46.2-1500 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 46.2-1500. Definitions.
11	Unless the context otherwise requires, the following words and terms for the purpose of this chapter
12	shall have the following meanings:
13	"Board" means the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board.
14 15	"Certificate of origin" means the document provided by the manufacturer of a new motor vehicle, or its distributor, which is the only valid indication of ownership between the manufacturer, its distributor,
16	its franchised motor vehicle dealers, and the original purchaser not for resale.
17	"Dealer-operator" means the individual who works at the established place of business of a dealer
18	and who is responsible for and in charge of day-to-day operations of that place of business.
19	"Distributor" means a person who is licensed by the Department of Motor Vehicles under Chapter 19
20	(§ 46.2-1900 et seq.) of this title and who sells or distributes new motor vehicles pursuant to a written
21 22	agreement with the manufacturer, to franchised motor vehicle dealers in the Commonwealth. "Distributor branch" means a branch office licensed by the Department of Motor Vehicles under
$\frac{22}{23}$	Chapter 19 (§ 46.2-1900 et seq.) of this title and maintained by a distributor for the sale of motor
23 24	vehicles to motor vehicle dealers or for directing or supervising, in whole or in part, its representatives
25	in the Commonwealth.
26	"Distributor representative" means a person who is licensed by the Department of Motor Vehicles
27	under Chapter 19 (§ 46.2-1900 et seq.) of this title and employed by a distributor or by a distributor
28	branch, for the purpose of making or promoting the sale of motor vehicles or for supervising or
29 30	contacting its dealers, prospective dealers, or representatives in the Commonwealth. "Factory branch" means a branch office maintained by a person for the sale of motor vehicles to
31	distributors or for the sale of motor vehicles to motor vehicle dealers, or for directing or supervising, in
32	whole or in part, its representatives in the Commonwealth.
33	"Factory representative" means a person who is licensed by the Department of Motor Vehicles under
34	Chapter 19 (§ 46.2-1900 et seq.) of this title and employed by a person who manufactures or assembles
35	motor vehicles or by a factory branch for the purpose of making or promoting the sale of its motor
36 37	vehicles or for supervising or contacting its dealers, prospective dealers, or representatives in the Commonwealth.
38	"Factory repurchase motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle sold, leased, rented, consigned, or
<b>39</b>	otherwise transferred to a person under an agreement that the motor vehicle will be resold or otherwise
40	retransferred only to the manufacturer or distributor of the motor vehicle, and which is reacquired by the
41	manufacturer or distributor, or its agents.
42	"Family member" means a person who either (i) is the spouse, child, grandchild, spouse of a child,
43 44	spouse of a grandchild, brother, sister, or parent of the dealer or owner or (ii) has been employed continuously by the dealer for at least five years.
45	"Franchise" means a written contract or agreement between two or more persons whereby one
46	person, the franchisee, is granted the right to engage in the business of offering and selling, servicing, or
47	offering, selling, and servicing new motor vehicles of a particular line-make or late model or factory
48	repurchase motor vehicles of a particular line-make manufactured or distributed by the grantor of the
49 50	right, the franchisor, and where the operation of the franchisee's business is substantially associated with
50 51	the franchisor's trademark, trade name, advertising, or other commercial symbol designating the franchisor, the motor vehicle or its manufacturer or distributor. The term shall include any severable part
51 52	or parts of a franchise agreement which separately provides for selling and servicing different line-makes
53	of the franchisor.
54	"Franchised late model or factory repurchase motor vehicle dealer" means a dealer in late model or
55	factory repurchase motor vehicles, including a franchised new motor vehicle dealer, that has a franchise
56 57	agreement with a manufacturer or distributor of the line-make of the late model or factory repurchase
57 58	motor vehicles. "Franchised motor vehicle dealer" means a dealer in new motor vehicles that has a franchise
59	agreement with a manufacturer or distributor of new motor vehicles, trailers, or semitrailers.

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60 "Fund" means the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board Fund.

61 "Independent motor vehicle dealer" means a dealer in used motor vehicles.

62 "Late model motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle of the current model year and the immediately 63 preceding model year.

64 "Line-make" means the name of the motor vehicle manufacturer or distributor and a brand or name plate marketed by the manufacturer or distributor. 65

"Manufacturer" means a person who is licensed by the Department of Motor Vehicles under Chapter 66 19 (§ 46.2-1900 et seq.) of this title and engaged in the business of constructing or assembling new 67 68 motor vehicles and, in the case of trucks, also means a person engaged in the business of manufacturing engines, power trains, or rear axles, when such engines, power trains, or rear axles are not warranted by 69 70 the final manufacturer or assembler of the truck.

71 'Motor vehicle" means the same as provided in § 46.2-100, except, for the purposes of this chapter, 72 it shall not include (i) trailers and semitrailers; (ii) manufactured homes, sales of which are regulated under Chapter 4.2 (§ 36-85.16 et seq.) of Title 36; (iii) motor homes; (iv) motorcycles; (v) nonrepairable 73 vehicles, as defined in § 46.2-1600; and (vi) salvage vehicles, as defined in § 46.2-1600; or (vii) mobile 74 75 cranes that exceed the size or weight limitations as set forth in §§ 46.2-1105, 46.2-1110, 46.2-1113, or Article 17 (§ 46.2-1122 et seq.) of Chapter 10 of this title. "Motor vehicle dealer" or "dealer" means any person who: 76 77

78 1. For commission, money, or other thing of value, buys, sells, exchanges, either outright or on 79 conditional sale, bailment lease, chattel mortgage, or otherwise or arranges or offers or attempts to 80 solicit or negotiate on behalf of others a sale, purchase, or exchange of an interest in new motor vehicles, new and used motor vehicles, or used motor vehicles alone, whether or not the motor vehicles 81 are owned by him; or 82

83 2. Is wholly or partly engaged in the business of selling new motor vehicles, new and used motor 84 vehicles, or used motor vehicles only, whether or not the motor vehicles are owned by him; or

85 3. Offers to sell, sells, displays, or permits the display for sale, of five or more motor vehicles within 86 any twelve12 consecutive months. 87

The term "motor vehicle dealer" does not include:

88 1. Receivers, trustees, administrators, executors, guardians, conservators or other persons appointed 89 by or acting under judgment or order of any court or their employees when engaged in the specific 90 performance of their duties as employees. 91

2. Public officers, their deputies, assistants, or employees, while performing their official duties.

92 3. Persons other than business entities primarily engaged in the leasing or renting of motor vehicles 93 to others when selling or offering such vehicles for sale at retail, disposing of motor vehicles acquired for their own use and actually so used, when the vehicles have been so acquired and used in good faith 94 95 and not for the purpose of avoiding the provisions of this chapter.

4. Persons dealing solely in the sale and distribution of fire-fighting equipment, ambulances, and 96 97 funeral vehicles, including motor vehicles adapted therefor; however, this exemption shall not exempt any person from the provisions of §§ 46.2-1519, 46.2-1520 and 46.2-1548. 98

99 5. Any financial institution chartered or authorized to do business under the laws of the Commonwealth or the United States which may have received title to a motor vehicle in the normal 100 course of its business by reason of a foreclosure, other taking, repossession, or voluntary reconveyance 101 102 to that institution occurring as a result of any loan secured by a lien on the vehicle.

103 6. An employee of an organization arranging for the purchase or lease by the organization of 104 vehicles for use in the organization's business.

7. Any person licensed to sell real estate who sells a manufactured home or similar vehicle in 105 106 conjunction with the sale of the parcel of land on which the manufactured home or similar vehicle is 107 located.

108 8. Any person who permits the operation of a motor vehicle show or permits the display of motor 109 vehicles for sale by any motor vehicle dealer licensed under this chapter.

9. An insurance company authorized to do business in the Commonwealth that sells or disposes of 110 111 vehicles under a contract with its insured in the regular course of business.

112 10. Any publication, broadcast, or other communications media when engaged in the business of advertising, but not otherwise arranging for the sale of vehicles owned by others. 113 114

11. Any person dealing solely in the sale or lease of vehicles designed exclusively for off-road use.

12. Any credit union authorized to do business in Virginia, provided the credit union does not 115 receive a commission, money, or other thing of value directly from a motor vehicle dealer. 116

13. Any person licensed as a manufactured home dealer, broker, manufacturer, or salesperson under 117 Chapter 4.2 (§ 36-85.16 et seq.) of Title 36. 118 119

14. The State Department of Social Services or local departments of social services.

"Motor vehicle salesperson" or "salesperson" means any person who is licensed as and employed as a 120 salesperson by a motor vehicle dealer to sell or exchange motor vehicles. It also means any person who 121

is licensed as a motor vehicle dealer and who sells or exchanges motor vehicles. 122

123 "Motor vehicle show" means a display of motor vehicles to the general public at a location other 124 than a dealer's location licensed under this chapter where the vehicles are not being offered for sale or 125 exchange during or as part of the display.

126 "New motor vehicle" means any vehicle which (i) has not been previously sold except in good faith 127 for the purpose of resale, (ii) has not been used as a rental, driver education, or demonstration motor 128 vehicle, or for the personal and business transportation of the manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or any of 129 his employees, (iii) has not been used except for limited use necessary in moving or road testing the 130 vehicle prior to delivery to a customer, (iv) is transferred by a certificate of origin, and (v) has the 131 manufacturer's certification that it conforms to all applicable federal motor vehicle safety and emission 132 standards. Notwithstanding provisions (i) and (iii), a motor vehicle that has been previously sold but not 133 titled shall be deemed a new motor vehicle if it meets the requirements of provisions (ii), (iv), and (v).

134 "Original license" means a motor vehicle dealer license issued to an applicant who has never been 135 licensed as a motor vehicle dealer in Virginia or whose Virginia motor vehicle dealer license has been 136 expired for more than thirty30 days. 137

"Relevant market area" means as follows:

138 1. In metropolitan localities, the relevant market area shall be a circular area around an existing 139 franchised dealer with a population of 250,000, not to exceed a radius of ten10 miles, but in no case 140 less than seven miles.

141 2. If the population in an area within a radius of ten10 miles around an existing franchised dealer is 142 less than 250,000, but the population in an area within a radius of fifteen 15 miles around an existing 143 franchised dealer is 150,000 or more, the relevant market area shall be that area within the 144 fifteen15-mile radius.

145 3. In all other cases the relevant market area shall be an area within a radius of twenty20 miles 146 around an existing franchised dealer or the area of responsibility defined in the franchise, whichever is 147 greater. In any case where the franchise agreement is silent as to area of responsibility, the relevant 148 market area shall be the greater of an area within a radius of twenty20 miles around an existing 149 franchised dealer or that area in which the franchisor otherwise requires the franchisee to make 150 significant retail sales or sales efforts.

151 In determining population for this definition, the most recent census by the U.S. Bureau of the 152 Census or the most recent population update, either from the National Planning Data Corporation or 153 other similar recognized source, shall be accumulated for all census tracts either wholly or partially 154 within the relevant market area.

155 "Retail installment sale" means every sale of one or more motor vehicles to a buyer for his use and 156 not for resale, in which the price of the vehicle is payable in one or more installments and in which the 157 seller has either retained title to the goods or has taken or retained a security interest in the goods under 158 form of contract designated either as a security agreement, conditional sale, bailment lease, chattel 159 mortgage, or otherwise.

160 "Sale at retail" or "retail sale" means the act or attempted act of selling, bartering, exchanging, or otherwise disposing of a motor vehicle to a buyer for his personal use and not for resale. 161

"Sale at wholesale" or "wholesale" means a sale to motor vehicle dealers or wholesalers other than to 162 163 consumers; a sale to one who intends to resell.

164 "Used motor vehicle" means any vehicle other than a new motor vehicle as defined in this section.

165 "Wholesale auction" means an auction of motor vehicles restricted to sales at wholesale.
