8 9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 9.1-902 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 9.1-902. Offenses requiring registration.
12	A. For purposes of this chapter:
13	"Offense for which registration is required" means:
14	1. A violation or attempted violation of §§ 18.2-63, 18.2-64.1, 18.2-67.2:1, 18.2-90 with the intent to
15	commit rape, § 18.2-374.1 or subsection D of § 18.2-374.1:1; or a third or subsequent conviction of (i)
16	§ 18.2-67.4, (ii) subsection C of § 18.2-67.5 or (iii) § 18.2-386.1;
17	2. Where the victim is a minor or is physically helpless or mentally incapacitated as defined in
18	§ 18.2-67.10, a violation or attempted violation of subsection A of § 18.2-47, clause (i) or (iii) of
19	§ 18.2-48, § 18.2-67.4, subsection C of § 18.2-67.5, § 18.2-361, or § 18.2-366, or clause (ii) or (iii) of
20	subsection B of § 18.2-374.3;
21	3. A violation of Chapter 117 (18 U.S.C. § 2421 et seq.) of Title 18 of the United States Code; or
22 23	4. A "sexually violent offense." "Sexually violent offense" means a violation or attempted violation of:
23 24	1. Clause (ii) of § 18.2-48, §§ 18.2-61, 18.2-67.1, 18.2-67.2, 18.2-67.3, subsections A and B of
25	\$ 18.2-67.5, $$ 18.2-370$ or $$ 18.2-370.1$; or
2 6	2. Sections 18.2-63, 18.2-64.1, 18.2-67.2:1, § 18.2-90 with the intent to commit rape or, where the
27	victim is a minor or is physically helpless or mentally incapacitated as defined in § 18.2-67.10, a
28	violation or attempted violation of subsection A of § 18.2-47, § 18.2-67.4, subsection C of § 18.2-67.5,
29	clause (i) or (iii) of § 18.2-48, §§ 18.2-361, 18.2-366, or § 18.2-374.1. Conviction of an offense listed
30	under this subdivision shall be deemed a sexually violent offense only if the person has been convicted
31	of any two or more such offenses, provided that person had been at liberty between such convictions.
32	B. "Offense for which registration is required" and "sexually violent offense" shall also include any
33	similar offense under the laws of the United States or any political subdivision thereof.
