

VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

An Act to clarify municipal or recreational purpose restrictions on real property acquired by the Commonwealth or any locality.

Approved

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. § 1. Any municipal or recreational purpose restriction placed on real property, located wholly or in part in the City of Virginia Beach, and acquired by the Commonwealth or from the Commonwealth by such locality on or after July 1, 1993, shall be satisfied if the property is used for tourism purposes that benefit the locality's tourism industry. For purposes of this act, "the property" refers to an approximately 1.068 acre parcel that is a portion of property known as Tract 4 and that the Commonwealth was directed to convey to the City pursuant to Chapter 690 of the Acts of Assembly of 1994.
