14	No locality shall have the authority to prohibit the display, during the 30 days before a general,
15	primary, special, or referendum election, of political campaign signs on private or public property if the
16	signs have been posted with the permission of the owner of the property and in compliance with
17	right-of-way restrictions. For the purposes of this section, the term "political campaign signs" means
18	only those signs that comply with the basic disclosure requirements for political campaign
19	advertisements set out in § 24.2-943. The provisions of this section shall supercede the provisions of any

20 local ordinance or regulation in conflict with this section.
