Presiding Officer; Mayor; Vice-Mayor; Their Powers and Duties. 12 13 (a) The council shall elect one of its members to preside over its meetings, who shall be ex officio 14 mayor of the city for a term of two (2) years, and any vacancy in the office shall be filled by election 15 by the council for the unexpired term. The mayor shall have the same powers and duties as other 16 members of the council, with a vote, but no veto. He shall be the official and ceremonial head of the city, but shall have no jurisdiction or authority to hear, try or determine any judicial matters. The 17 council shall also elect one of its members as vice-mayor, who shall act as mayor during the absence or 18

(b) The mayor may resign the office of mayor without giving up his or her membership on council.

(c) The council may, by unanimous vote of the council members other than the mayor, remove the mayor from the office of mayor.

(d) In case of either (b) or (c), a replacement would immediately be elected by a majority vote of council to serve for the remainder of the term.
