Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article X a section numbered 7-B, relating to the Transportation Trust Fund.

234567 8 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, a majority of the members elected to 9 each house agreeing, That the following amendment to the Constitution of Virginia be, and the same hereby is, proposed and referred to the General Assembly at its first regular session held after the next 10 general election of members of the House of Delegates for its concurrence in conformity with the 11 provisions of Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely: 12

13 Amend the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article X a section numbered 7-B as follows: 14

ARTICLE X

TAXATION AND FINANCE

16 Section 7-B. Transportation Trust Fund.

The General Assembly shall continue and maintain the Transportation Trust Fund (the Fund), which 17 shall receive one hundred percent of the revenues generated through the sales and use taxes, motor 18 vehicle registration fees, motor vehicle sales and use taxes, and motor vehicle fuels taxes imposed 19 20 pursuant to Chapters 11, 12, and 15 of the Acts of Assembly, 1986 Special Session and any later 21 enactment dedicating additional revenues to the Fund. The General Assembly may appropriate additional moneys to the Fund. All interest, dividends, and appreciation accruing to the Fund shall be 22 23 part of the Fund. Money in the Fund may be invested as authorized by law.

24 The General Assembly shall appropriate the proceeds of the Fund only for purposes of constructing, improving, and maintaining the roads embraced in the systems of state highways for the Commonwealth 25 26 and its localities and furthering the interests of the Commonwealth in the areas of highways, public 27 transportation, railways, seaports, and airports.

28 The General Assembly shall enact such laws as may be necessary to maintain the Fund and 29 implement the provisions of this section.

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
