044343756 **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 256** 1 2 Offered March 8, 2004 3 Commending the Virginia Union University men's basketball team. 4 Patrons-Marsh, Lambert, Locke, Lucas and Miller 5 6 WHEREAS, established during Reconstruction, Virginia Union University enjoys the enviable 7 reputation as a bulwark for higher education, academic and civic leadership, and athletic prowess; and 8 WHEREAS, always in the pursuit of excellence, the University, since joining the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) as a charter member, has been in the forefront of athletic 9 10 achievement; and WHEREAS, many of the University's coaches have become legends in their own time, including 11 Henry Hucles, Thomas "Tricky Tom" Harris, Dave Robbins, and Willard Bailey; and 12 13 WHEREAS, some of its alumni athletes have achieved distinguished careers in the professional leagues or in coaching, such as National Basketball Association stars Charles Oakley, Terry Davis, and 14 15 Ben Wallace, defensive player of the year for 2002; and WHEREAS, with this legacy of excellence and well experienced with success due to an outstanding 16 17 athletic program, the Virginia Union University mens basketball team ("Panthers") returned to the CIAA championship in February 2004, seeking the championship title; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the team overcame a partisan crowd, a serious size disadvantage, mediocre first-half 20 shooting, and a halftime deficit to defeat North Carolina Central University 80-72, in the 59th CIAA 21 Championship Tournament; and 22 WHEREAS, steadily increasing its second-half lead to as many as 12 points to win the game, the 23 University captured its 18th CIAA championship title, 11 of which were won during the 26-season 24 tenure of head coach Dave Robbins; and 25 WHEREAS, for more than 25 years, the Panthers have flourished under the leadership of Head Coach Robbins, the Division II coach with the second highest number of wins; and 26 27 WHEREAS, under his leadership, the Panthers hold the record for the highest field goal percentage 28 ever in the CIAA, and during his tenure, he has helped to mold the successful careers of professional 29 ball players, and has had 10 student-athletes named Most Valuable Player; and 30 WHEREAS, it is with immense pride that the citizens of the Commonwealth commend the Panthers 31 and Coach Dave Robbins for their remarkable feat, perseverance, and constant pursuit of excellence; now, therefore, be it 32 33 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring. That the General Assembly hereby 34 commend the Virginia Union University men's basketball team; and, be it
