4. Title Accident and sickness insurance; coverage for household members.

5. Summary/Purpose: Adds “household members” to those eligible for coverage under a group health insurance certificate of coverage for a family unit. The bill defines “household member” as meaning “any person in whom the insured has an insurable interest pursuant to subdivision B 1 or B 2 of § 38.2-301 who resides in the same household as the insured.”
