4. Title University of Mary Washington.

Changes the name of Mary Washington College to the University of Mary Washington. This past year, the Carnegie Foundation, which certifies on a national basis the classification of all institutions of higher learning, reclassified MWC as a university, rather than a baccalaureate liberal arts college based upon the number of graduate degrees awarded. The Board of Visitors of Mary Washington College approved the name change unanimously on November 22, 2003.

8. Fiscal implications: There are minimal printing, signage and other costs related to an institutional name change, but none of these would have a significant fiscal impact on the institution.
