4. Title Virginia Fair Housing Law; evidence of unlawful discriminatory practices.

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill provides that the use of words or symbols associated with a particular religion, national origin, sex, or race may be evidence of an illegal preference under the Virginia Fair Housing Law. Current law mandates that the use of such words or symbols shall be prima facie evidence of an illegal preference. The bill also removes language preventing the use of a general disclaimer. The bill also makes a number of technical changes to the Virginia Fair Housing Law.
