4. Title Pneumatic guns.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Defines pneumatic guns and establishes restrictions on use of pneumatic guns, paintball guns and sawed-off weapons. The bill also provides for the establishment of local ordinances to regulate pneumatic guns.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: It is not possible at this time to determine the number of localities that would implement this provision, the maximum penalty assessed, or how many persons would be convicted under this legislation. However, any revenue garnered from the bill is expected to be minimal because the maximum fine for Class 3 misdemeanors is \$500 and a Class 4 misdemeanor is \$250. Any revenue generated from the enactment of this bill would be deposited to the locality.
