3. Committee Transportation

4. Title: Vans; operation and safety inspections of those used to transport certain passengers.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Requires driver's license endorsement for persons who operate nine-fifteen passenger vans.
Requires safety inspection of vans every six months.

6. Fiscal Impact is preliminary. See Item 8 below.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications:

This bill would create a new driver's license endorsement for a driver who operates a van capable of transporting at least nine but no more than fifteen passengers (including the driver). The van must be used to transport passengers on behalf of a church; school; day care center, program, or facility; or any other public or quasi-public entity. In order to receive the endorsement, the driver would be required to pass a special written examination and road test and meet additional qualifications and requirements. Since the number of individuals who would apply for this new endorsement is unknown, the impact on DMV operations cannot be determined.
