5. **Summary/Purpose:** Amends the Code of Virginia at § 4.1-209, 4.1-210, 4.1-231, and 4.1-233 and creates a new annual banquet license for wine and beer and an annual mixed beverage banquet license. Both licenses are limited to no more than 12 events per calendar year. The provisions set out the application fee and the state and local taxes for these new licenses.
