Requires local public entities proceeding under the Public-Private Education Facilities and Infrastructure Act of 2002 to hire a qualified professional to provide an independent analysis of the advantages, disadvantages, and the short- and long-term costs of the proposal of the private entity, unless the governing body of the public entity determines that the public entity can perform the analysis with its own employees.
